
# Collaboration in GIS: the West Parry Sound Geography Network



## **Our Network**

- Partnership of 7 Municipalities, 2 Planning Boards
  - West half of Parry Sound District (6,000 sq km)
  - Surrounds Town of Parry Sound but area coverage includes predominately rural areas
    - > 22 Communities
    - > 30,000 islands, 1482 inhabited
    - > 400+ inhabited lakes
    - > Large tracts of Crown Land, Parks, Conservation Reserves
    - > 24,000 land parcels in coverage area
      - >> 10,122 Seasonal
      - >> 5.046 Permanent
    - > 1,281 named roads containing 3,810 road segments.





## **Organization Overview**

- Named 'West Parry Sound Geography Network', the Network is a municipal collaboration to provide shared geomatic services among multiple organizations.
  - > Mandate to address municipal data and geospatial needs. Services have since emerged to support many public uses.
- Organizational Structure
  - Administered by one "lead" municipality (use of Corporation's name).
  - Partnership established by Memorandum of Understanding
  - Operating budget supported by all partners through membership fees.
  - Operational resources managed by "lead" municipality.
    - > Coordinator (employee of lead municipality)
    - > 'GIS Data Management Specialist' is only dedicated employee of Network
    - > Centralized Resources (infrastructure) IT Support





## **Evolution of 'Network'**

- Originated with lead municipality's existing GIS
- 2004-05 catalyst for growth/expansion was funding opportunities
- Strategic Plan and recommendations paved way for:
  - Parnership (governed by Memorandum of Understanding)
  - Shared and centralized resources
  - New dedicated GIS staff (shared amongst partners)
- Staff acceptance, Pulbic use
- Technology advances





## Key growth aspects of the Network

- Lead organization (Champion)
- Opportunities (funding, savings, efficencies)
- Existing needs must be identified
  - Support community services
  - Fullfill Municipal business requirements (services)
  - Expertise
- Technology consumed by community



## Key aspect to the Networks success

- Efficient, simple, effective delivery of services.
  - o Browser & internet connection ONLY requirements
- Users have seamless access to many different datasets
  - Municipal Partners (specific data needs internal)
  - Community /Public (general uses)
- ability to let partners manage their own data
- selfserve tools and services
- active communities engaging their municipalities (collaboration, participation, awareness)




## **Services of the Network**



Polygon




## **Data of the Network**

- Community Data Businesses, Points of Interest, Communities




## **Benefits and Achievements**
